



Hayloft

The Hayloft is the Community Centre for many social activities and is for the exclusive use of Bayshore Members in good standing and invited guests.

The Hayloft may be rented for private functions.

The Board of Directors must approve any requested functions.

To comply with Fire and Safety regulations, occupancy is restricted to:

Non-fixed chairs: 150 persons

Fixed chairs/tables: 110 persons

Not permitted in the Hayloft:
Smoking, non-service pets, children under 16 yrs., unless accompanied and supervised by an adult, 18 years of age or older.



Swimming Pool

Bayshore Village operates a heated swimming pool from June until September for members in good standing. Entrance requires your member access card.

The pool is maintained in accordance with rules and regulations of the Health Department.

Lifeguard on Duty- 30 persons

No Lifeguard- 10 persons

Children under 16 yrs must be supervised by an adult 18 yrs or older.

An emergency telephone is located on the outside Hayloft wall.

Posted rules MUST be followed.

Boat Harbours 33, 66, 99

Boat Harbour use is an optional additional fee amenity.

The harbour 'water areas' are owned by Bayshore.

All boats using a harbour, must have appropriate insurance.

Maximum speed is 3 knots/NO WAKE.

Boat slips are assigned by the Harbour Director.

Please remove all garbage and help to keep Bayshore beautiful.

Golf

The golf course is intended for golfing only.

Weekly, annual, and special golf events are organized by the Golf Committee.

BVA golf tags are available from the Hayloft office and must be displayed on your golf bag.

An adult member must accompany persons under 16 years of age.

Golf shoes or running shoes must be worn on the course.

No more than 4 players in a party.

No dogs are permitted on the course unless authorized by the golf committee.

Storage Yard

The storage yard is for the exclusive use of members in good standing.

All items stored are at the sole risk of the member and must be insured.

Any item improperly parked may be moved at the discretion of the Harbour/Storage Director.

Members will be allowed 1 item as room permits. The item being stored must be owned by the member.

Any item in the storage yard that has not been moved for a period of 12 months will be considered a non-use item and the member will be asked to remove it in order to make room for other members who are on the waiting list.
