

# **Driveway Entrance Permits—Working Within Road Allowances**

Under Bylaw 2017.43, Driveway Entrance Permits are required in the Township of Ramara if you are establishing, constructing, repairing, altering or relocating an entrance. To get a copy of a Driveway Entrance application form, please contact Ashley Watson at <a href="mailto:awatson@ramara.ca">awatson@ramara.ca</a> or visit the Ramara website and find the application under 'Forms and Permits'. Property owners will follow the following process:

- 1. Property owner will complete application, stake the location and pay for inspection fees at the Township building.
- 2. Works will check to ensure location is acceptable and determine size of culvert, size of driveway and material needed and relay information back to property owner.
- 3. Property owner will provide contractor information and schedule an inspection to occur during the installation.

## **CIS - Community Information System**

Get alerted about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for Ramara Community Information System (CIS). Ramara CIS uses the Everbridge system which allows the Township to use multiple means of communication for both Emergency Alerts and relaying Community Information. You will only receive the information you choose to receive. In addition to your home phone you can add mobile phones, Voice over IP landlines, e-mail and/or text messaging to be included to receive messages from Ramara CIS. You can also choose the order in which you receive the notifications. These systems allow the Township to easily and effectively communicate with residents and interested parties through all of today's available technology. Your alerts, Your way.



# Information for Residents on Municipal Water and Sewers

**WATER TURN ON/OFF**— For your protection against leaks, breaks or blockages, it is mandatory for someone to be onsite to confirm the water is ON/OFF. Township of Ramara Environmental Services requires 24 hour notice for this procedure. All charges for these services are in accordance with the Township of Ramara Fees and Charges Bylaw

**Selling Your Home?** - If you are selling your home, please ensure your lawyer contacts the municipal office to provide pertinent information such as closing date, new owners contact information and arrange for a final read of your water meter.

**Sewer Use Bylaw**—The discharge of storm water, surface water, ground water or sump pump into sanitary sewers is strictly prohibited.



# **LAGOON CITY PARKS AND WATERWAYS COMMISSION**

A History of Lagoon City

Weeds are prevalent in the canals and the Commission has the following programs in place:

1. Harvesting – takes place each week on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays between July 1<sup>st</sup> and Thanksgiving. The Commission does not have any place to store the weeds and therefore cutting can only take place when the landfill site is open. The harvester will be seen out in the canals from May 1<sup>st</sup>, but it will only be skimming debris from the surface. Due to fish spawning no cutting may take place prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.

2. Weed Spraying – takes place annually as soon as possible after July 1<sup>st</sup> after fish spawning season has taken place. This is regulated by the Ministry of the Environment. The licence to spray REWARD is for 10 acres at a rate of 25 litres per acre and must be applied for annually. Therefore the only the areas that are affected by abundant weed growth are sprayed.

# **On-Site Sewage Maintenance Inspection Program**

Effective January 1st, 2011, the Ontario Building Code was amended by Ontario Regulation 315/10 to establish and govern mandatory on-site sewage system maintenance inspection programs to be administered by the Township of Ramara. Click to view Ontario Regulation 315/10.

This amendment helps protect Ontario's drinking water and the natural environment and support the implementation of the Clean Water Act, 2006 (CWA) and the Lake Simcoe Protection Plan.

Inspections of all on-site sewage systems within this boundary will be inspected, and then re-inspected every five years thereafter.

You will receive a notice if your property is within this boundary, the inspection will be completed simultaneously during the spring/summer months by our Building Department staff and a notice will be left on your door.

Once the inspection is completed you will receive an invoice for \$150.00. Please be advised after 30 days if the invoice is unpaid the fee will be transferred to your property tax account.

The second component of the program is that you are responsible for arranging a licensed sewage hauler to have your septic or holding tank pumped out.


# Fleming Quarry Expansion - File # OP-1/17 Z-8/17
