



#### **2018 PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS**

#### **Courtland Street (Balsam Road to Anderson Avenue)**

#### 1) The Courtland Street project includes:

- six culverts,
- remaining pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- ditching as needed,
- road reshaping,
- double hi float surface treatment by September 30, 2018

#### The following closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project:

#### 1) Orkney Beach Road at Courtland Street

Orkney Beach Road will be closed between Courtland Street and Prophet Park Crescent with no through access on Tuesday, July 3, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until complete. Courtland street will remain open but may be down to one lane near Orkney Beach road. The approximate time for reopening Orkney Beach Road on Tuesday, July 3, 2018 is 7:00 p.m., weather permitting. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 2) Courtland Street north of Orkney Beach Road

Courtland Street will be closed between Orkney Beach Road and Mara Park with no through access on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until complete. All access will be from Orkney Beach Road to Orkney Heights. The approximate time for reopening on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 is 2:00 p.m. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 3) Cedar Point Lane at Courtland Street

Cedar Point Lane will be restricted to one lane with some long delays. This work will begin immediately after the Courtland street culvert on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 starting approximately at 2:00 p.m. and is estimated to be completed by Thursday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. Updates will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 4) Anderson Avenue at Courtland Street

Anderson Avenue will be restricted to one lane with some long delays. This work will begin on Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 a.m. and is estimated to be completed by Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Updates will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 5) Concession Road 10 and Courtland Street

Concession Road 10 will be restricted to one lane with some long delays. This work will begin on Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 a.m. and is estimated to be completed by Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. Updates will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 6) Courtland Street between Anderson Avenue and Cedar Point Lane

Courtland street will be restricted to one lane with some long delays. This work will begin on Wednesday, July 11, 2018 at 7:00 a.m. and is estimated to be complete by Thursday, July 12<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. Updates will be advertised through our Everbridge system.

#### 2) Switch Road (Rama Road - McMillan Sideroad)

The Switch Road project includes:

- seven culverts.
- pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- ditching as needed,
- road reshaping,
- asphalt paving by September 15, 2018.

The following closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project

#### 1) Switch Road between #3188 and #3230

On Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 a.m. until Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at approximately noon, the area on Switch Road between #3188 and #3230 will be closed for culvert replacement. To access #3230 Switch Road use Rama Road. All other properties can only be accessed from County Road 169.

#### 2) Switch Road between McMillan Sideroad to #2956 Switch Road

On Monday, July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. McMillan Sideroad to #2956 Switch Road will be closed for culvert replacement. Properties numbered #2956 and above will have access from Rama Road, properties number less than# 2956 can only be accessed from County Road 169.

#### 3) Fern Resort Road (Rama Road to lake)

The Fern Resort Road project includes:

- Culvert flushing, inspection and possible replacement,
- pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- ditching as needed,
- road reshaping,
- asphalt paving by September 15, 2018.

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 4) Prospect Avenue (Fern Resort Road to approximately #5232)

The Prospect Avenue project includes:

- Culvert flushing, inspection and possible replacement,
- pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- ditching and shouldering as needed,
- road reshaping,
- asphalt paving by September 15, 2018.

#### 5) Harrigan Drive (County Road 47 to Concession Road 3)

The Harrigan Drive project includes:

- Pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- road reshaping,
- asphalt paving by September 15, 2018

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 6) Fawn Bay Road (Rama Road to south end)

The Fawn Bay Road project includes:

- Culvert flushing, inspection and possible replacement,
- pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- ditching/drainage improvements and shouldering as needed,
- road reshaping,
- double hi float surface treatment by September 30, 2018.

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 7) Beaver Trail (Lake Avenue to cul-de-sac)

The Beaver Trail project includes:

- Pulverization last week of July to the beginning of August,
- Additional gravel,
- road reshaping,
- drainage improvements,
- double hi float surface treatment by September 30, 2018.

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 8) Glen Cedar Drive (Hill from McRae Park Road to approximately #4017)

The Glen Cedar Drive project includes:

double hi float surface treatment by September 30, 2018.

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 9) Amilia Drive (Louis Lane to Glenrest Drive)

The Amilia Drive project includes:

- Brushing
- Road reshaping
- double hi float surface treatment by September 30, 2018.

No closures/lane reductions have been scheduled for this project as of yet

#### 10) Fairgrounds Road (Birch Drive to Brooks Sideroad)

The cross culvert between Birch Drive and Brooks Sideroad is scheduled to be replaced July 31, 2018. There will be no through access from 7:00 a.m. until complete. The approximate time for reopening Fairgrounds Road on Tuesday, July 31, 2018 is 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system. Properties numbered 2883 and above will have access from County Road 169. Properties numbered 2854 and below will have access from Brooks Sideroad.

#### 11) Concession Road 12 (East of Fairvalley Road)

The cross culvert on Concession Road 12 at Fairvalley Road on the east side is scheduled to be replaced August 1, 2018. There will be no through access from 7:00 a.m. until complete. The approximate time for reopening Concession Road 12 on Wednesday August 1, 2018 is 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system. Properties numbered 3146 and below will have access from Sideroad 15.

#### 12) Sideroad 20 (Concession Road 7 to Concession Road 8)

The cross culvert on Sideroad 20 north of Concession Road 7 is scheduled to be replaced August 7, 2018. There will be no through access from 7:00 a.m. until complete. The approximate time for reopening Sideroad 20 on Tuesday August 7, 2018 is 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system. Bayshore and area residents will have access via Concession Road 7 only during this closure. Concession Road 8 residents will have access via Muley Point Road.

#### 13) Orkney Beach Road (#4473 to #4506)

The cross culvert on Orkney Beach Road west of the former Montessori school between 4473 and 4506 is scheduled to be replaced August 8, 2018. There will be no through access from 7:00 a.m. until completion August 9, 2018. The approximate time for reopening Orkney Beach Road is Thursday August 9, 2018 at 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Reopening will be advertised through our Everbridge system. Properties numbered 4506 and above will have access via Courtland Street. Properties numbered 4473 and below will have access via Orkney Heights.

#### 14) Concession Road 7 (Highway 12 to County Road 169)

The cross culvert west of the railway tracks is expected to be tendered for replacement later this year. This will involve a full closure for several weeks. #2375 will have access via Highway 12. #2243 will have access via County Road 169.

## Information for Residents on Municipal Water and Sewers

**WATER TURN ON/OFF**— For your protection against leaks, breaks or blockages, it is mandatory for someone to be onsite to confirm the water is ON/OFF. Township of Ramara Environmental Services requires 24 hour notice for this procedure. All charges for these services are in accordance with the Township of Ramara Fees and Charges Bylaw

**Selling Your Home?** - If you are selling your home, please ensure your lawyer contacts the municipal office to provide pertinent information such as closing date, new owners contact information and arrange for a final read of your water meter.

**Sewer Use Bylaw**—The discharge of storm water, surface water, ground water or sump pump into sanitary sewers is strictly prohibited.



#### LAGOON CITY PARKS AND WATERWAYS COMMISSION

A History of Lagoon City

Weeds are prevalent in the canals and the Commission has the following programs in place:

1. Harvesting – takes place each week on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays between July 1<sup>st</sup> and Thanksgiving. The Commission does not have any place to store the weeds and therefore cutting can only take place when the landfill site is open. The harvester will be seen out in the canals from May 1<sup>st</sup>, but it will only be skimming debris from the surface. Due to fish spawning no cutting may take place prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.

2. Weed Spraying – takes place annually as soon as possible after July 1<sup>st</sup> after fish spawning season has taken place. This is regulated by the Ministry of the Environment. The licence to spray REWARD is for 10 acres at a rate of 25 litres per acre and must be applied for annually. Therefore the only the areas that are affected by abundant weed growth are sprayed.

#### **BUILDING AND PLANNING SERVICES**

#### **On-Site Sewage Maintenance Inspection Program**

Effective January 1st, 2011, the Ontario Building Code was amended by Ontario Regulation 315/10 to establish and govern mandatory on-site sewage system maintenance inspection programs to be administered by the Township of Ramara. Click to view Ontario Regulation 315/10.

This amendment helps protect Ontario's drinking water and the natural environment and support the implementation of the Clean Water Act, 2006 (CWA) and the Lake Simcoe Protection Plan.

Inspections of all on-site sewage systems within this boundary will be inspected, and then re-inspected every five years thereafter.

You will receive a notice if your property is within this boundary, the inspection will be completed simultaneously during the spring/summer months by our Building Department staff and a notice will be left on your door.

Once the inspection is completed you will receive an invoice for \$150.00. Please be advised after 30 days if the invoice is unpaid the fee will be transferred to your property tax account.

The second component of the program is that you are responsible for arranging a licensed sewage hauler to have your septic or holding tank pumped out.

#### 2018 Official Plan Update

In conjunction with EcoVue Consulting Ltd., the Township of Ramara is currently undertaking a review of the Official Plan. The Official Plan contains goals, objectives and policies that guide Township Council, its Committees, Boards, Officials and the public with regard to land use and physical changes and their effects on economic, environmental and community consideration in the Township. The first draft of the document has been received by municipal staff who are working with the consultants in anticipation of bringing the draft plan to Council. Every effort was made to date to include all policy directions as well as public consultation comments. Once the first stage of the review has been completed, the draft document will be amended to reflect any required changes to the text and draft schedule pages prior to presenting the first draft of the updated Official Plan to Council, stakeholders and the public. 




